- Beef: 7:30-8:30 AM
- Sheep and Goat Weigh-In: 7:30-9:00 AM

\*\*Animals will be shown off the trailer and there is no electricity provided. Shade will be limited so please plan accordingly and bring a generator and pop-up tent if needed. Water sources will be available but washing animals will be limited. \*\*



#### **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. All animals must be present at the show facilities during the check-in times to allow for class scheduling and weighing of sheep and goats.
- 2. Health certificates are not required for the show but animals deemed unfit will be disqualified at the discretion of the NC Department of Agriculture. Any animal showing signs of contagious diseases will be asked to leave immediately.
- 3. To show in breeding stock classes, heifers, ewes, and does must be born between January 2022 and March 2024.
- 4. Heifers will be grouped based on birth date. All goats and sheep will be grouped based on weight. Exhibitors may show does and ewes in their respective market classes but will be unable to enter the same animal in the breeding classes.
- 5. Market classes will be divided by weight. Show management reserves the right to rearrange classes as needed.
  - a. All lambs must have baby teeth in place at the time of the show
- 6. Cabarrus County Cooperative Extension will not be responsible for any damages, death, injury, or property loss incurred by or to any exhibitor or their animal.
- 7. Age divisions are based on the exhibitor's age on January 1st
- 8. The showmanship competition will be divided into six age categories:
  Non-Competitive Special Needs (All Ages), Peewee (5 years and under), Cloverbud (5-7 years old), Junior (8-10 years old), Intermediate (11-13 years old), & Senior (14-18 years old)
- 9. Awards will be given for overall division winners.
- 10. Cloverbud showmanship classes are non-competitive. Cloverbuds are allowed to show in the breed/market classes.
- 11. Animals must be halter broken. Exhibitors with unruly animals may be asked to leave the show ring.
- 12. Abuse of animals will not be tolerated and can result in disqualification from the show.
- 13. All sheep and goats must comply with USDA and N.C. Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services Scrapie Eradication Program guidelines. Sheep and goats without scrapie tags or registration papers with corresponding tattoo information at the time of check-in will not be allowed. Scrapie Flock ID numbers must be presented at the time of check-in. Call 1-866-USDATAG or 919-855-7707 for more information. Veterinary Division staff will be onsite to inspect your animal. Show Superintendent or Judge may refuse to allow animals to enter or show that appear sick or show signs of infection.
- 14. If an exhibitor has more than one animal in a class, the second entry may be shown by another eligible youth.
- 15. There will NOT be a sale of market lambs.
- 16. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES will be allowed
- 17. Restroom facilities will be available.
- 18. Concessions will be available for purchase.
- 19. Animals will be released upon the completion of their respective show
