# **General Circuit Rules**

- Attention non-circuit and circuit participants: This year, the 4-H Farm Credit Showmanship Circuit requires
  participants to register by 5:00 pm on July 19, 2024. You will then need to <u>register for county shows</u>
  <u>individually.</u>
- 2. All participants are welcome as long as they're enrolled in 4-H online.
- 3. All participants must be between ages 5-19 (as of January 1, 2024).
- 4. For the Lee County show (non-circuit and circuit members), you may register by Fairentry.com 2024 Lee Regional Fair. Registration opens on June 17th. The deadline to register for the Lee County show is August 30th.
- 5. Exhibitors may show a maximum of two animals in each species/category. Either one doe one wether or two does or two wethers. If an exhibitor has more than one animal in a class, the second animal must be shown by another exhibitor approved during registration. Adults are not eligible.
- 6. All animals must be halter broken. Unruly, hard-to-handle, or dangerous animals will be asked to leave the ring.
- 7. All animals must meet North Carolina health requirements. Unhealthy animals will be excluded from competition at the discretion of the show director.
- 8. All rules are subject to change at the show official's discretion. All decisions will be final.
- 9. Please call 919-775-5624 for information or questions concerning the Lee County Show.

\*\*All show animals must be removed from the barn within 1 hour after the conclusion of the show\*\*

**Exhibitor Conduct:** Exhibitors and their immediate family members found cheating, misrepresenting, or participating in fraud or deception or acting unsportsmanlike shall be disqualified and possibly barred from future competitions. The show officials reserve the right to exclude from competition any entry which is late entering the show ring.


# SANFORD LIONS CLUB – LEE COUNTY REGIONAL FAIRGROUNDS

# MEAT GOAT SHOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS Wednesday, September 11, 2024 | 6:00 pm

- 1. Health certificates are not required for the shows but any animals deemed unfit may be disqualified at the discretion of the North Carolina Department of Agriculture. Any animal or exhibitor showing signs of contagious diseases will NOT be allowed to show and may be asked to leave the show grounds immediately. Sick or thin animals will not be accepted.
- 2. All goats must meet NCDA Scrapies regulations. Those animals that do not will be asked to leave the fairgrounds. If you do not know this requirement, learn more at NCDA&CS Veterinary Division.
- 3. Goats will be shown on Wednesday, September 11, 2024, at 6:00 pm. Wether weigh-in & doe check-in from 4:00 pm-5:30 pm. Show order: Showmanship, Does, Wethers.
- 4. All goat classes (wethers & does) will be divided by weight as evenly as possible thirty minutes before the show. Animals will only be weighed once.
- 5. All youth ages 5-7 (Cloverbuds) will not be judged but will exhibit non-competitively and receive a participation ribbon and a \$10 premium.
- 6. Pens are not available. No overnight boarding of animals is permitted.
- 7. All show animals must be removed from the barn within 1 hour after the show's conclusion.

# CATTLE SHOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS Thursday, September 12, 2024 | 6:00

- 1. Open to youth exhibitors 9-19 (as of January 1, 2024) and North Carolina residents. No Cloverbuds (ages 5-7) may participate. Exhibitors should be part of the 4-H Farm Credit Showmanship Circuit.
- 2. All breeds will be shown in one class.
- 3. Check-in: 4:00pm-5:30pm. Show order: Heifers, Steers, Showmanship.
- 4. Heifer Classes will be divided based on the heifer's age. A Grand and Reserve Champion will be selected from the class winners.
- 5. Steers must be halter broke and dehorned.
- 6. Steer classes will be divided by steer weights (light, middle and heavy). A Grand and Reserve Champion will be selected from the class winners. If there is more than one weight class, premiums will be given for each class.
- 7. Please bring tie-out ropes, pens are not available.
- 8. All show animals must be removed from the barn within one hour after the conclusion of the show
- 9. All rules are subject to change per show official's discretion. All decisions will be final.
