Attention non-circuit and circuit participants: The 4-H Farm Credit Showmanship Circuit is requiring participants to register to participate in the circuit by 5:00 pm on July 19, 2024. Registration is through Eventbrite and there is a \$25.00 convenience fee. You will then need to register for county shows individually. For the Anson County show (non-circuit and circuit members), you may register [HERE](#). The deadline to register for the Anson County's show is Friday, August 16th.

Open to all exhibitors that were less than 19 years old on January 1, 2024.

Showmanship classes will comply with NC 4-H guidelines:

- Cloverbud placings are non-competitive.
- Registration for the overall circuit will be through Eventbrite. There is a \$25 convenience fee.
- Individual county show registrations will be on 4-H online so participants must be enrolled in 4-H Online: <https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in>
- The deadline to register for Non-Circuit Showmen is Friday, August 16th by 5pm

Show classes can be added, combined, split, and/or omitted by the show committee.

Unethical treatment of animals (as determined by the Show Committee) will not be allowed.

Neither the show committee, the Anson County Cattlemen's Association nor the owner or operator show facility (hay barn) shall be held liable for damages related to death, injury or loss of property incurred by or to any exhibitor or their animal. Each exhibitor shall be responsible for any damages.

Health papers are NOT required for this show. Animals that exhibit potential health risk will not be allowed in the barn or show.

All Ages are as of January 1st of 2024

Class 1- PeeWees. Ages less than 5. **Eligible for Participation ONLY.**

Class 2-Cloverbuds. Ages 5-7. **Eligible for Participation ONLY.**

Class 3- Juniors. Ages 8-10. Competition class

Class 4- Intermediates. Ages 11-13. Competition class

Class 5- Seniors. Ages 14-18. Competition class

British Breeds Division – Purebred and Commercial Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and crosses of these breeds. Must be less than 25% Continental or Brahma influence.

Class 6- Heifers born after Jan. 1, 2024

Class 7- Heifers born Nov. and Dec. 2023

Class 8- Heifers born Sept. and Oct. 2023

Class 9- Heifers born May, June, July and August 2023

Class 10- Heifers born Jan., Feb., March, and April 2023

Class 11- Heifers born Sept., Oct., Nov., and Dec. 2023

Grand Champion British Breed Heifer – Reserve Champion British Breed Heifer

Continental Breeds Division – Purebred Continental, Continental cross of 25% and higher, and Brahma influence heifers.

Class 12- Heifers born after Jan. 1, 2024

Class 13- Heifers born Nov. and Dec. 2023

Class 14- Heifers born Sept. and Oct. 2023

Class 15- Heifers born May, June, July and August 2023

Class 16- Heifers born Jan., Feb., March, and April 2023

Class 17- Heifers born Sept., Oct., Nov., and Dec. 2022
